3. Matters arising from 2025 AGM – Under item 9, points (b), (c) & (d) number of matters were discussed that required further clarification/communication to the membership and/or approval from the membership;
  - (b) A discussion paper on Category 2 players will be circulated in due course with a view to discussion at the Spring Meeting and possible formal rule changes at the 2026 AGM to take effect in the 2027 season. This is necessary due to the changing nature of domestic cricket, specifically wrt the Metro Bank Cup – NO PROGRESS
  - (c) The Executive will undertake a review of the term “home grown” will be undertaken with a view to bringing forward amendments at the Spring meeting to clarify/ strengthen the definition. – NO PROGRESS
  - (d) A new pitch marking scheme it is being considered and will be reviewed further before potentially being presented to clubs at the Spring Meeting – JdS set out the broad new principles that we hope should lead to less contention.
